
GUIDELINES TO RESUME DART LEAGUES

May 11 to July 4, 2020.

It is our goal to resume dart leagues in the safest way possible. As each Game Time location re-opens, we will adhere to the state recommended social distancing guidelines. This will change the way leagues can be played. Things will not be as they were prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dart leagues will not resume in full until the State of Indiana lifts all restrictions which is tentatively planned for July 4th.

In the meantime, you will be able to continue your league matches as locations re-open, but you are not required to. A limit has been placed on the number of matches playable at one time based on the number of boards at a location. Please use the guide below when playing league matches. Note, if a league has 12 teams and 6 boards, only 3 matches can be played at one time. This may require some flexibility in start times.

<i># boards</i>	2	3	4	5	6
<i># matches</i>	1	2	2	3	3

If you choose to play during this time, we ask that you work with your fellow darters to play your matches at times and in settings you and your opponent are comfortable with. We ask that you be considerate to your fellow dart players. Just because you might be comfortable going back into a bar does not mean everyone else will be. We will need to be patient with each other. We will do our best to complete each league in a timely manner but ultimately there will be delays.

We are not going to follow the 2-week make time from May 11 to July 3 and matches will not be forfeited during this time. Banquets will be suspended until after all restrictions have been lifted. During this time, if a league is completed, payouts will be sent via PayPal to each player. It will be the players responsibility to provide their PayPal information to Game Time.

The winter/spring MADA tournament has been moved to August 20-23rd. This change is subject to the State of Kentucky reopening and allowing gatherings large enough to accommodate the tournament. Look for more information to follow in the coming weeks.
